Maldives is one of the few countries that have banned trawling nets and long-line fishing. This means that the marine ecosystem is sustainable and growing in abundance of fish and marine life. The healthy reefs hold various great game fish species such as Giant Trevally, Dogtooth Tuna, Groupers, Coral Trouts, Snappers, Barracudas, Wahoo, big Yellowfin Tuna, Dorado, Sailfish and Marlin.

This destination also offers very unique fishing opportunities which can provide uncommon catches like the Broadbill Swordfish, the mighty Oilfish, and some monster Bigeye Tuna.

BOAT



Our boat will be a fantastic fishing machine 30 feet center console sport fishing vessel with twin Yamahas 200hp, reaching speeds of 30kn without any problem, and max speeds of 40kn.

With a maximum capacity of 4 anglers, to make sure you fish in the best conditions and comfortability possible. Trolling, electric reels and stand up gear are available on the boat.

We have a massive fuel tank and a 100 liters freshwater tank aboard, along with modern electronics, radar & fish finder, toilet, and stereo system.

Our native crew it's professional and very experienced. They are having amazing results in the area, and they are always looking for new and untouched fishing grounds.

The captain it's been obsessed with fishing all his life, spending the last several years chasing top game fish such as GTs, Yellowfins and Dogtooth Tuna.

SURROUNDINGS



Maldives is home to the top beaches in the world, which they're on almost every one of the country's nearly 1.200 islands, and are so consistently perfect that it's hard not to become blasé about them. While some beaches may boast softer granules than others, the basic fact remains: you won't find consistently whiter-than-white powder sand and luminous cyan-blue water like this anywhere else on earth. This fact alone is enough to bring well over a million people a year to this tiny, remote Indian Ocean paradise.

Maldives has undergone seismic change in the past 10 years, since inhabited islands have been opened to tourism and locals have permission to build their own guesthouses. Travelers no longer have to stay in resorts and remain separate from the local population, something that kept backpackers away for decades. Island hopping by public ferry, speedboat and domestic flights has opened up this incredible country to visitors on almost all budgets.

With some of the best diving and snorkeling in the world, the clear waters of Maldives are a magnet for anyone with an interest in marine life. The richness and variety is astonishing, with dazzling coral walls, magnificent caves and schools of brightly colored tropical fish await you when you get down to the reef. In deeper waters lurk manta rays, turtles, sharks and even the world's largest fish, the whale shark. The best bit? The water is so warm many people don't even wear a wetsuit.

OTHER ACTIVITIES



Male. For us, Malé will be only the main gate to get into the southern atolls, but we can always do one or two day layovers if someone is interested. Snappers, Angel Fish, Tunas aside, the overhanging caves surrounding the coral cove and the reef are the most exclusive sights one cannot miss while scuba diving.

Surfing is one of the most beloved watersports, however not every ocean-facing landmass is ideal for surfing, gigantic waves that curl up at the optimal time offers that worthy time frame to surf, and makes Maldives one of the most favorite surfing destinations in the entire world. USEFUL INFORMATION



As a year-round destination, it's almost always a good time to go to Maldives. However, if you want guaranteed sunshine, it's best to aim for December to March for your visit. Outside those months there will be plenty of sunshine, but it will be broken up by rain and clouds. Travelers can expect little rain, low humidity and blue skies. Our trips will be scheduled normally around April, offering the best fishing opportunities and the best weather.

Maldives doesn't have a high risk of, anyway make sure you are up-to-date on all routine vaccines before every trip. There are no mandatory vaccinations, and Yellow Fever vaccine it's required only if traveling from a country with risk of transmission and ≥ 9 months of age. The risk of Malaria and Dengue diseases are almost nonexistent, anyway it's always a good idea to prevent mosquito bites.

Passengers travelling to the Maldives as tourists must have a confirmed hotel reservation for their stay at a registered tourist facility, as we will have in our trip. The visa it's on arrival and each passenger must have their own passport regardless of age. Immigration and Health self-declaration form must be filled within 24 hours prior to the flight. The maximum number of days granted on arrival would be 30 days.

Maldives uses power outlets and plugs of types C, D, G, J, K & L, so better bring a universal adapter. Power sockets in Maldives provide a standard voltage of 230V with a standard frequency of 50Hz.

The currency it's the maldivian rufiyaa (RF). Bargaining is not part of Maldivian culture and should not be attempted in most situations. Credit cards can be used in resorts and most guesthouses. ATMs can be found in Male and the bigger inhabited islands.

Boats and all enterprises have their own insurance, anyway it's always better to have your own health and travel insurance.
